Our instructional team has successfully implemented reading interventions, small group instruction that targets student needs, English learner strategies, periodic practice state testing that informs instruction, and enrichment activities that include singing, playing musical instruments, and martial arts.


Invictus will continue focusing on improving attendance and the percentage of our students who are meeting their grade-level standards.

Since the beginning of this school year, the percentage of students moving one performance band has increased by 25% (Math) and 10% (ELA).

Our team has implemented focused groups to help our student reach grade-level proficiency and accelerate achievement.

Attendance is such a big part of academic outcomes. We cannot stress how important your child attending every day is. Please ensure your child is present so we can get them into excellent outcomes.

From our first trimester academic data, further improvement is needed in our overall proficiency rates, particularly for grades 3 and above. Exceptional focus is being given to grades our upper grades (5-8) for mastery of math concepts and mastery of composition (writing skills) for grades 3-8.

Our students are now in even smaller groups for targeted instruction that is geared to address concepts they are ready to learn, and receive extra assistance with concepts that they are struggling with. Please remember to have your child present

ILA is please to have zero expulsions and single digit suspensions so far this year, with our suspension rate dropping to 0.84% of enrollment.

Invictus will continue to utilize alternatives to suspension and use misbehavior as opportunities to reteach correct behaviors when appropriate.
